Mr. ROBB (for himself and Mr. WARNER) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

## A BILL

To designate certain land of the National Forest System located in the State of Virginia as wilderness.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Virginia Wilderness  
5 Act of 2000”.

6 **SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF WILDERNESS AREAS.**

7 Section 1 of the Act entitled “An Act to designate  
8 certain National Forest System lands in the States of Vir-  
9 ginia and West Virginia as wilderness areas” (Public Law  
10 100–326; 102 Stat. 584) is amended—

1           (1) in paragraph (5), by striking “and” at the  
2 end;

3           (2) in paragraph (6), by striking the period and  
4 inserting a semicolon; and

5           (3) by adding at the end the following:

6           “(7) certain land in the George Washington  
7 National Forest, comprising approximately 6,500  
8 acres, as generally depicted on a map entitled ‘The  
9 Priest Wilderness Study Area’, dated June 6, 2000,  
10 to be known as the ‘Priest Wilderness Area’; and

11           “(8) certain land in the George Washington  
12 National Forest, comprising approximately 4,800  
13 acres, as generally depicted on a map entitled ‘The  
14 Three Ridges Wilderness Study Area’, dated June 6,  
15 2000, to be known as the ‘Three Ridges Wilderness  
16 Area.’”.
