A BILL

To designate the Federal building located at 300 East 8th Street in Austin, Texas, as the “J.J. ‘Jake’ Pickle Federal Building”.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The Federal Building located at 300 East 8th Street
5 in Austin, Texas, shall be known and designated as the
6 “J.J. ‘Jake’ Pickle Federal Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
4 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
5 a reference to the “J.J. ‘Jake’ Pickle Federal Building”.

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
