A BILL

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1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF ROBERT C. WEAVER FED-**
2 **ERAL BUILDING.**

3 In honor of the first Secretary of Housing and Urban
4 Development, the headquarters building of the Depart-
5 ment of Housing and Urban Development located at 451
6 Seventh Street, SW., in Washington, District of Columbia,
7 shall be known and designated as the “Robert C. Weaver
8 Federal Building”.

9 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

10 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
11 paper, or other record of the United States to the building
12 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
13 to the “Robert C. Weaver Federal Building”.

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
