A BILL

To amend Public Law 105–188 to provide for the mineral
leasing of certain Indian lands in Oklahoma.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MINERAL LEASING OF CERTAIN INDIAN LANDS**

4 **IN OKLAHOMA.**

5 Public Law 105–188 (112 Stat. 620 and 621) is
6 amended—

1 (1) in the title, by inserting “and certain
 2 former Indian reservations in Oklahoma” after
 3 “Fort Berthold Indian Reservation”; and

4 (2) in section 1—

5 (A) by striking the section heading and in-
 6 serting the following:

7 **“SECTION 1. LEASES OF CERTAIN ALLOTTED LANDS.”;**

8 and

9 (B) in subsection (a)(1)(A), by striking
 10 clause (i) and inserting the following:

11 “(i) is located within—

12 “(I) the Fort Berthold Indian
 13 Reservation in North Dakota; or

14 “(II) a former Indian reservation
 15 located in Oklahoma of—

16 “(aa) the Comanche Indian
 17 Tribe;

18 “(bb) the Kiowa Indian
 19 Tribe;

20 “(cc) the Apache Tribe;

21 “(dd) the Fort Sill Apache
 22 Tribe of Oklahoma;

23 “(ee) the Wichita and Affili-
 24 ated Tribes (Wichita, Keechi,

1 Waco, and Tawakonie) located in
2 Oklahoma;
3 “(ff) the Delaware Tribe of
4 Western Oklahoma; or
5 “(gg) the Caddo Indian
6 Tribe; and”.

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
