Mrs. EMERSON introduced the following joint resolution; which was referred
to the Committee on the Judiciary

JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United
States relating to voluntary school prayer.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following article is hereby proposed as an amend-
4 ment to the Constitution of the United States, which shall
5 be valid to all intents and purposes as part of the Con-
6 stitution if ratified by the legislatures of at least three-
7 fourths of the several States within seven years from the
8 date of its proposal to the States by the Congress:

1 “ARTICLE —

2 “Nothing in this Constitution shall be construed to
3 prohibit individual or group prayer in public schools or
4 other public institutions. No person shall be required by
5 the United States or by any State to participate in prayer.
6 Neither the United States nor any State shall prescribe
7 the content of any such prayer.”.
