A BILL

To amend the Federal Credit Union Act with respect to
the definition of a member business loan.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Faith-Based Lending
5 Protection Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. MEMBER BUSINESS LOAN EXCEPTION.**

7 Section 107A(c)(1)(B) of the Federal Credit Union
8 Act (12 U.S.C. 1757a(c)(1)(B)) is amended—

1 (1) in clause (iv), by striking “or” after the
2 semicolon;

3 (2) in clause (v), by striking the period at the
4 end and inserting “; or”; and

5 (3) by inserting after clause (v) the following
6 new clause:

7 “(vi) that is made to a nonprofit reli-
8 gious organization.”.
