A BILL

To amend the Natural Gas Act to limit the extent to which natural gas prices charged to end users may be increased.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION.**

4 Section 4(a) of the Natural Gas Act (15 U.S.C.
5 717c(a)) is amended by adding at the end the following:
6 “A rate or charge made, demanded, or received, for a sale
7 in interstate commerce of natural gas to an end user, that
8 represents an increase in the rate or charge to such end

- 1 user in excess of 15 percent per month shall be deemed
- 2 to be not just and reasonable.”.
