A BILL

To amend the Act that established the Pu'uhonua O Honaunau National Historical Park to expand the boundaries of that park.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXPANSION OF BOUNDARIES OF PU'UHONUA O**
4 **HONAUNAU NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK.**

5 (a) EXPANSION.—The first section of the Act of July
6 26, 1955 (chapter 385; 16 U.S.C. 397), is amended by
7 adding at the end the following:

8 “PARCEL 4

9 “The lands within the boundaries depicted on the
10 map entitled ____ and dated ____, consisting of approxi-

1 mately 805 acres, subject to such minor adjustment of
2 such boundaries as may be considered by the Secretary
3 of the Interior to be necessary.”.

4 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—To ac-
5 quire lands and interests in lands within the boundaries
6 of the area added to Pu’uhonua O Honaunau National
7 Historical Park by subsection (a), there are authorized to
8 be appropriated to the Secretary of the Interior
9 \$20,000,000.
