A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. CONNECTICUT RIVER ATLANTIC SALMON COM-**
2 **PACT.**

3 (a) EFFECTIVE PERIOD OF CONGRESSIONAL CON-
4 SENT.—Section 3(2) of Public Law 98–138 (97 Stat. 870)
5 is amended by striking “twenty years” and inserting “40
6 years”.

7 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Public
8 Law 98–138 (97 Stat. 866) is amended by adding at the
9 end the following:

10 **“SEC. 6. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

11 “There is authorized to be appropriated to the Sec-
12 retary of the Interior to carry out the activities of the Con-
13 necticut River Atlantic Salmon Commission \$9,000,000
14 for each of fiscal years 2002 through 2010.”.
