3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF NATIONAL HANSEN'S DIS-**
4 **EASE PROGRAMS CENTER.**

5 (a) REFERENCES IN PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE
6 ACT.—Section 320(a)(1) of the Public Health Service Act
7 (42 U.S.C. 247e(a)(1)) is amended by striking “Gillis W.
8 Long Hansen's Disease Center” and inserting “National
9 Hansen's Disease Programs Center”.

1 (b) PUBLIC LAW 105–78.—References in section 211
2 of Public Law 105–78, and in deeds, agreements, or other
3 documents under such section, to the Gillis W. Long Han-
4 sen’s Disease Center shall be deemed to be references to
5 the National Hansen’s Disease Programs Center.

6 (c) OTHER REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law,
7 map, regulation, document, paper, or other record of the
8 United States to the Gillis W. Long Hansen’s Disease
9 Center shall be deemed to be a reference to the National
10 Hansen’s Disease Programs Center.
