5 (a) REPEAL OF LIMITATION ON FEDERAL EXPENDI-
6 TURES.—Subsection (b)(2)(A) of section 509 of title 32,

1 United States Code, is amended by striking “, except
2 that” and all that follows through “\$62,500,000”.

3 (b) MATCHING FUNDS.—Subsection (d) of such sec-
4 tion is amended by striking “may not exceed—” and all
5 that follows through the end of paragraph (4) and insert-
6 ing “for fiscal year 2002 and each subsequent fiscal year
7 may not exceed 75 percent of the costs of operating the
8 State program during that fiscal year.”.

9 (c) REPEAL OF CONTINGENT FUNDING FOR
10 JROTC.—(1) Section 2033 of title 10, United States
11 Code, is repealed.

12 (2) the table of sections at the beginning of chapter
13 102 of such title is amended by striking the item relating
14 to section 2033.
