## A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to study the suitability and feasibility of including certain lands along the southeastern coast of Maui, Hawaii, in the National Park System.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. STUDY.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 18 months after  
5       funds are made available for this section, the Secretary  
6       of the Interior shall complete a study, pursuant to the cri-  
7       teria set forth in paragraphs (2) and (3) of section 8(c)  
8       of Public Law 91–383 (16 U.S.C. 1a–5(c) (2) and (3);

1 commonly known as the National Park System General  
2 Authorities Act), of the suitability and feasibility of includ-  
3 ing the certain lands located on the southeastern coast of  
4 Maui, Hawaii, in the National Park System. The study  
5 area shall extend generally from Keone'o'io to Kanaloa  
6 Point.

7 (b) SUBMISSION TO CONGRESS.—Upon completion of  
8 the study, the Secretary shall submit the findings of the  
9 study to the Committee on Resources of the House of Rep-  
10 resentatives and the Committee on Energy and Natural  
11 Resources of the Senate.
