Mr. GREEN of Wisconsin introduced the following bill; which was referred to
the Committee on Government Reform

A BILL

To provide for the conveyance of the excess Army Reserve
Center in Kewaunee, Wisconsin.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LAND CONVEYANCE, ARMY RESERVE CENTER,**

4 **KEWAUNEE, WISCONSIN.**

5 (a) CONVEYANCE REQUIRED.—The Administrator of
6 General Services shall convey, without consideration, to
7 the City of Kewaunee, Wisconsin (in this section referred
8 to as the “City”), all right, title, and interest of the United
9 States in and to a parcel of Federal real property, includ-
10 ing improvements thereon, that is located at 401 5th

1 Street in Kewaunee, Wisconsin, and contains an excess
2 Army Reserve Center, for the purpose of permitting the
3 City to develop the parcel for public benefit.

4 (b) DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY.—The exact acreage
5 and legal description of the real property to be conveyed
6 under subsection (a) shall be determined by a survey satis-
7 factory to the Administrator. The cost of the survey shall
8 be borne by the City.

9 (c) ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The Ad-
10 ministrator may require such additional terms and condi-
11 tions in connection with the conveyance under subsection
12 (a) as the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the
13 interests of the United States.
