AN ACT

For the relief of Rabon Lowry of Pembroke, North Carolina.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SATISFACTION OF CLAIM.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Treasury
3 shall pay, out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise
4 appropriated, to Rabon Lowry of Pembroke, North Caro-
5 lina, individually and as president of Pembroke Machine
6 Company, Inc., the sum of \$1,000,000 for damages he in-
7 curred as a result of a breach of Government Contract
8 number DAAA09–85–C–0630 by the Department of the
9 Army.

10 (b) CONDITIONS OF PAYMENT.—The payment shall
11 be in full satisfaction of any claims Rabon Lowry or Pem-
12 broke Machine Company may have against the United
13 States arising from Government Contract number
14 DAAA09–85–C–0630.

15 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON AGENTS AND ATTORNEYS FEES.**

16 It shall be unlawful for an amount that exceeds 10
17 percent of the sum described in section 1 to be paid to
18 or received by any agent or attorney for any service ren-
19 dered in connection with the benefits provided by this Act.
20 Any person who violates this section shall be guilty of an
21 infraction and shall be subject to a fine in the amount
22 provided in title 18, United States Code.
