Mr. DIAZ-BALART, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2975) to combat
terrorism, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of
3 order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 2975) to
4 combat terrorism, and for other purposes. The bill shall
5 be considered as read for amendment. In lieu of the
6 amendment recommended by the Committee on the Judi-
7 ciary now printed in the bill, an amendment in the nature

1 of a substitute consisting of the text of H.R. 3108 shall
2 be considered as adopted. All points of order against the
3 bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question shall
4 be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended, to final
5 passage without intervening motion except: (1) one hour
6 of debate on the bill, as amended, equally divided and con-
7 trolled by the chairman and ranking minority member of
8 the Committee on the Judiciary; and (2) one motion to
9 recommit with or without instructions.
