Whereas President Musharraf has pursued the return of Pakistan to democracy and civil society;

Whereas President Musharraf has shown great fortitude in confronting extremists in Pakistan; and

Whereas the Pakistani-American community in the United States and people-to-people diplomacy between the citizens of the United States and Pakistan play an important role in building bridges between the two nations: Now, therefore, be it
