## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3009) to extend the Andean Trade Preference Act, to grant additional trade benefits under that Act, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of  
3 order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 3009) to  
4 extend the Andean Trade Preference Act, to grant addi-  
5 tional trade benefits under that Act, and for other pur-  
6 poses. The bill shall be considered as read for amendment.

1 The amendment recommended by the Committee on Ways  
2 and Means now printed in the bill shall be considered as  
3 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
4 dered on the bill, as amended, to final passage without  
5 intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate on the  
6 bill, as amended, equally divided and controlled by the  
7 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee  
8 on Ways and Means; and (2) one motion to recommit with  
9 or without instructions.
