A BILL

To provide for the management of environmental matters at the Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant, Kentucky, through the Assistant Secretary of Energy for Environmental Management.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MANAGEMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL MATTERS**

4 **AT PADUCAH GASEOUS DIFFUSION PLANT,**
5 **KENTUCKY.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Energy shall
7 provide for the management of environmental matters (in-
8 cluding planning and budgetary activities) with respect to

1 the Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant, Kentucky, through
2 the Assistant Secretary of Energy for Environmental
3 Management.

4 (b) PARTICULAR REQUIREMENTS.—(1) In meeting
5 the requirement in subsection (a), the Secretary shall pro-
6 vide for direct communication between the Assistant Sec-
7 retary of Energy for Environmental Management and the
8 head of the Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant on the mat-
9 ters covered by that subsection.

10 (2) The Assistant Secretary shall carry out activities
11 under this section in direct consultation with the head of
12 the Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant.

13 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR ENVI-
14 RONMENTAL ACTIVITIES.—There is hereby authorized to
15 be appropriated for the Department of Energy for fiscal
16 years after fiscal year 2001, such sums as may be nec-
17 essary for purposes of environmental activities at the Pa-
18 ducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant in such fiscal years.
