1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Office of Government
3 Ethics Authorization Act of 2001”.

4 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIA-**
5 **TIONS.**

6 Section 405 of the Ethics in Government Act of 1978
7 (5 U.S.C. App.) is amended by striking “1997 through
8 1999” and inserting “2002 through 2006”.
