Mrs. FEINSTEIN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To ban the importation of large capacity ammunition feeding devices.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Large Capacity Ammu-
5 nition Magazine Import Ban Act of 2001”.

1 **SEC. 2. BAN ON IMPORTING LARGE CAPACITY AMMUNI-**
 2 **TION FEEDING DEVICES.**

3 Section 922(w) of title 18, United States Code, is
 4 amended—

5 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “(1) Except as
 6 provided in paragraph (2)” and inserting “(1)(A)
 7 Except as provided in subparagraph (B)”;

8 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “(2) Para-
 9 graph (1)” and inserting “(B) Subparagraph (A)”;

10 (3) by inserting before paragraph (3) the fol-
 11 lowing new paragraph:

12 “(2) It shall be unlawful for any person to import
 13 a large capacity ammunition feeding device.”; and

14 (4) in paragraph (4)—

15 (A) by striking “(1)” each place it appears
 16 and inserting “(1)(A)”;

17 (B) by striking “(2)” and inserting
 18 “(1)(B)”.

19 **SEC. 3. CONFORMING AMENDMENT.**

20 Section 921(a)(31) of title 18, United States Code,
 21 is amended by striking “manufactured after the date of
 22 enactment of the Violent Crime Control and Law Enforce-
 23 ment Act of 1994”.
