## A BILL

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to provide permanent authority for the admission of “S” visa nonimmigrants.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. PERMANENT AUTHORITY FOR ADMISSION OF**  
4               **“S” VISA NONIMMIGRANTS.**

5       Section 214(k) of the Immigration and Nationality  
6       Act (8 U.S.C. 1184(k)) is amended—

7               (1) by striking (2);

8               (2) by redesignating paragraphs (3), (4), and

9               (5) as paragraphs (2), (3), and (4), respectively; and

- 1 (3) in paragraph (4)(E) (as redesignated), by
- 2 striking “paragraph (4)” and inserting “paragraph
- 3 (3)”.
