A BILL

To amend the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act to limit the use of the common name “catfish” in the marketing of fish.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON THE USE OF THE COMMON**
4 **NAME “CATFISH” IN THE MARKETING OF**
5 **FISH.**

6 Chapter IV of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic
7 Act is amended by inserting after section 403C (21 U.S.C.
8 343–3) the following:

1 **“SEC. 403D. LIMITATION ON THE USE OF THE COMMON**
2 **NAME ‘CATFISH’ IN THE MARKETING OF FISH.**

3 “For the purposes of section 403, the name ‘catfish’
4 or any name that includes the word ‘catfish’ shall be used
5 only in reference to a fish of the family Ictalariidae.”.
