A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to convey a former Bureau of Land Management administrative site to the City of Carson City, Nevada, for use as a senior center.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. CONVEYANCE OF CERTAIN BUREAU OF LAND**
2 **MANAGEMENT LANDS IN CARSON CITY, NE-**
3 **VADA.**

4 (a) CONVEYANCE.—Not later than 120 days after the
5 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Inte-
6 rior, acting through the Director of the Bureau of Land
7 Management, shall convey to the City of Carson City, Ne-
8 vada, without consideration, all right, title, and interest
9 of the United States in the property described as Govern-
10 ment lot 1 in sec. 8, T. 15 N., R. 20 E., Mount Diablo
11 Meridian, as shown on the Bureau of Land Management
12 official plat approved October 28, 1996, containing ap-
13 proximately 4.48 acres, including any uninhabitable build-
14 ings and improvements.

15 (b) USE.—The conveyance of the property under sub-
16 section (a) shall revert to the United States if the Sec-
17 retary determines that the property is used for a purpose
18 other than the purpose of a senior assisted living center
19 (or a related public purpose).

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
