AN ACT

For the relief of Rita Mirembe Revell (a.k.a. Margaret Rita Mirembe).

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR RITA**
4 **MIREMBE REVELL (A.K.A. MARGARET RITA**
5 **MIREMBE).**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
7 sion of law, for the purposes of the Immigration and Na-
8 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.), Rita Mirembe Revell
9 (a.k.a. Margaret Rita Mirembe) shall be held and consid-

1 ered to have been lawfully admitted to the United States
2 for permanent residence as of the date of enactment of
3 this Act, upon payment of the required visa fees not later
4 than 2 years after the date of enactment of this Act.

5 (b) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBERS.—
6 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Rita
7 Mirembe Revell (a.k.a. Margaret Rita Mirembe), the Sec-
8 retary of State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce
9 by the appropriate number, during the current or next fol-
10 lowing fiscal year, the total number of immigrant visas
11 that are made available to natives of the country of the
12 alien's birth under section 203(a) of the Immigration and
13 Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)) or, if applicable, the
14 total number of immigrant visas that are made available
15 to natives of the country of the alien's birth under section
16 202(e) of such Act.
