To authorize representation by the Senate Legal Counsel

Whereas Senator Kay Bailey Hutchison has been named as
a defendant in the case of Judith Lewis v. Rick Perry,
et al., Case No. 01–10098–D, now pending in the Dis-
trict Court for Dallas County, Texas; and

Whereas, pursuant to sections 703(a) and 704(a)(1) of the
Ethics in Government Act of 1978, 2 U.S.C. §§ 288b(a)
and 288c(a)(1), the Senate may direct its counsel to rep-
resent Members of the Senate in civil actions with respect
to their official responsibilities: Now, therefore, be it

2 ized to represent Senator Hutchison in the case of Judith
