CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Regarding consent to assemble outside the seat of government.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That pursuant to clause 4, section 5, article
3 I of the Constitution, during the One Hundred Eighth
4 Congress the Speaker of the House and the Majority
5 Leader of the Senate or their respective designees, acting
6 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader Of the
7 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, may notify
8 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,
9 to assemble at a place outside the District of Columbia

1 whenever, in their opinion, the public interest shall war-
2 rant it.
