Monument, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXCHANGE OF LANDS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding ~~any other provi-~~
 5 ~~sion of law~~ *section 5(b) of Public Law 90–401 (16 U.S.C.*
 6 *460l–22(b))*, the Secretary of the Interior is authorized to
 7 convey to Christ Church of St. Simons Island, Georgia,
 8 the approximately 6.0 acres of land within the boundary

1 of Fort Frederica National Monument adjacent to Christ
2 Church and depicted as “NPS Lands for Exchange” on
3 the map entitled “Fort Frederica National Monument
4 2003 Boundary Revision” numbered 369/80016, and
5 dated April 2003, in exchange for approximately 8.7 acres
6 of land to be acquired by Christ Church, which is depicted
7 as “Private Lands for Addition” on the same map.

8 (b) MAP AVAILABILITY.—The map referred to in sub-
9 section (a) shall be on file and available for public inspec-
10 tion in the appropriate offices of the National Park Serv-
11 ice.

12 **SEC. 2. BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT.**

13 Upon completion of the land exchange under sub-
14 section (a) of section 1, the Secretary of the Interior shall
15 revise the boundary of Fort Frederica National Monument
16 to reflect the exchange and shall administer the land ac-
17 quired through the exchange as part of that monument.

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
