AN ACT

To provide for additional lands to be included within the
boundary of the Johnstown Flood National Memorial
in the State of Pennsylvania, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Johnstown Flood Na-
5 tional Memorial Boundary Adjustment Act of 2003”.

1 **SEC. 2. BOUNDARY OF JOHNSTOWN FLOOD NATIONAL ME-**
2 **MORIAL.**

3 The boundary of the Johnstown Flood National Me-
4 morial (“Memorial”) is modified to include the area as
5 generally depicted on the map entitled “Johnstown Flood
6 National Memorial, Cambria County, Commonwealth of
7 Pennsylvania”, numbered N.E.R.O. 427/80,008 and dated
8 June, 2003. The map shall be on file and available for
9 inspection in the appropriate offices of the National Park
10 Service, Department of the Interior.

11 **SEC. 3. ACQUISITION OF LANDS.**

12 The Secretary of the Interior (“Secretary”) is author-
13 ized to acquire from willing sellers the land or interests
14 in land as described in section 2 by donation, purchase
15 with donated or appropriated funds, or exchange.

16 **SEC. 4. ADMINISTRATION OF LANDS.**

17 Lands added to the Memorial by section 2 shall be
18 administered by the Secretary as part of the Memorial in
19 accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

20 **SEC. 5. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

21 In addition to amounts otherwise made available for
22 land acquisition, there are authorized to be appropriated
23 such sums as may be necessary to carry out the purposes
24 of this Act.

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
