3 **SECTION 1. ADMIRAL DONALD DAVIS POST OFFICE BUILD-**
4 **ING.**

5 (a) REDESIGNATION.—The facility of the United
6 States Postal Service located at 201 West Boston Street
7 in Brookfield, Missouri, and known as the Brookfield Main

1 Office, shall be known and designated as the “Admiral
2 Donald Davis Post Office Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the Admiral Donald Davis
7 Post Office Building.

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
