2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF SPECIAL IMMIGRANT RELI-**
2 **GIOUS WORKER PROGRAM.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 101(a)(27)(C)(ii) of the
4 Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
5 1101(a)(27)(C)(ii)) is amended by striking “2003,” each
6 place it appears and inserting “2008,”.

7 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
8 subsection (a) shall take effect on October 1, 2003.

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
