2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. JAMES E. WORSHAM POST OFFICE.**

4 (a) REDESIGNATION.—The facility of the United
5 States Postal Service located at 7715 S. Cottage Grove

1 Avenue in Chicago, Illinois, shall be known and designated
2 as the “James E. Worsham Post Office”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in this section shall be
6 deemed to be a reference to the James E. Worsham Post
7 Office.

8 **SEC. 2. JAMES E. WORSHAM CARRIER ANNEX BUILDING.**

9 (a) REDESIGNATION.—The facility of the United
10 States Postal Service located at 7748 S. Cottage Grove
11 Avenue in Chicago, Illinois, shall be known and designated
12 as the “James E. Worsham Carrier Annex Building”.

13 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
14 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
15 States to the facility referred to in this section shall be
16 deemed to be a reference to the James E. Worsham Car-
17 rier Annex Building.

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
