2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. GEORGE HENRY WHITE POST OFFICE BUILD-
4 ING.

(a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States Postal Service located at 525 Main Street in Tarboro, North Carolina, shall be known and designated as the “George Henry White Post Office Building”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
4 be deemed to be a reference to the George Henry White
5 Post Office Building.

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
