1 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.**

2 Section 17(c)(1) of the Stevenson-Wydler Technology
3 Innovation Act of 1980 (15 U.S.C. 3711a(c)(1)) is amend-
4 ed by adding at the end the following:

5 “(F) Nonprofit organizations.”.

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
