AN ACT

To expand the Timucuan Ecological and Historic Preserve,
Florida.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Timucuan Ecological
3 and Historic Preserve Boundary Revision Act of 2004”.

4 **SEC. 2. REVISION OF BOUNDARY OF TIMUCUAN ECOLOGI-
5 CAL AND HISTORIC PRESERVE, FLORIDA.**

6 Section 201(a) of Public Law 100–249 (16 U.S.C.
7 698n) is amended—

8 (1) by striking “(a) ESTABLISHMENT.—There
9 is hereby” and inserting the following:

10 “(a) ESTABLISHMENT.—

11 “(1) IN GENERAL.—There is”; and

12 (2) by adding at the end the following:

13 “(2) MODIFICATION OF BOUNDARY.—

14 “(A) IN GENERAL.—In addition to the
15 land described in paragraph (1), the Preserve
16 shall include approximately 8.5 acres of land lo-
17 cated in Nassau County, Florida, as generally
18 depicted on the map entitled ‘Timucuan Eco-
19 logical and Historic Preserve American Beach
20 Adjustment’, numbered 006/80012 and dated
21 June 2003.

22 “(B) DUTIES OF SECRETARY.—The Sec-
23 retary of the Interior shall—

24 “(i) revise the boundaries of the Pre-
25 serve so as to encompass the land de-
26 scribed in subparagraph (A); and

1 “(ii) maintain the map described in
2 subparagraph (A) on file and available for
3 public inspection in the appropriate offices
4 of the National Park Service.”.
