AN ACT

To reinstate and extend the deadline for commencement of
construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of Illinois.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FEDERAL ENERGY**
4 **REGULATORY COMMISSION PROJECT.**

5 Notwithstanding the time period specified in section
6 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would
7 otherwise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Com-
8 mission project numbered 11214, the Commission may, at

1 the request of the licensee for the project, and after rea-
2 sonable notice, in accordance with the good faith, due dili-
3 gence, and public interest requirements of that section and
4 the Commission's procedures under that section—

5 (1) reinstate the license for the construction of
6 the project as of the effective date of the surrender
7 of the license; and

8 (2) extend the time period during which the li-
9 censee is required to commence the construction of
10 the project for 3 consecutive 2-year periods beyond
11 the date that is 4 years after the date of issuance
12 of the license.
