1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MCINNIS CANYONS NATIONAL CONSERVATION**
4 **AREA.**

5 (a) PURPOSE.—The Colorado Canyons National Con-
6 servation Area and Black Ridge Canyons Wilderness Act
7 of 2000 (16 U.S.C. 460mm et seq.) is amended in sec-
8 tion 2(b) by striking “Colorado Canyons” and inserting
9 “McInnis Canyons”.

10 (b) DEFINITIONS.—Section 3 of such Act is
11 amended—

12 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “Colorado”
13 and inserting “McInnis”; and

14 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “Colorado”
15 and inserting “McInnis”.

16 (c) COLORADO CANYONS NATIONAL CONSERVATION
17 AREA.—Section 4 of such Act is amended—

18 (1) in the heading, by striking “**COLORADO**”
19 and inserting “**MCINNIS**”; and

20 (2) in subsection (a), by striking “Colorado
21 Canyons” and inserting “McInnis Canyons”.

22 (d) ADVISORY COUNCIL.—Section 8(a) of such Act
23 is amended by striking “Colorado Canyons” and inserting
24 “McInnis Canyons”.

1 (e) SHORT TITLE.—Section 1 of such Act is amended
2 by striking “Colorado” and inserting “McInnis”.

3 (f) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the “Colorado Canyons National Conservation
6 Area” shall be deemed to be a reference to the “McInnis
7 Canyons National Conservation Area”.

8 (g) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section and the amend-
9 ments made by this section take effect on January 1,
10 2005.
