1 **SECTION 1. LIEUTENANT GENERAL JAMES V. EDMUNDSON**

2 **POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

3 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
4 Postal Service located at 560 Bay Isles Road in Longboat
5 Key, Florida, shall be known and designated as the “Lieutenant General James V. Edmundson Post Office Building”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
9 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
10 be deemed to be a reference to the Lieutenant General
11 James V. Edmundson Post Office Building.

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
