Mr. REYNOLDS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5025) making appropriations for the Departments of Transportation and Treasury, and independent agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2005, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 5025) making appropriations for

1 the Departments of Transportation and Treasury, and
2 independent agencies for the fiscal year ending September
3 30, 2005, and for other purposes. The first reading of the
4 bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against
5 consideration of the bill are waived. General debate shall
6 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equal-
7 ly divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
8 nority member of the Committee on Appropriations. Dur-
9 ing consideration of the bill for amendment, the Chairman
10 of the Committee of the Whole may accord priority in rec-
11 ognition on the basis of whether the Member offering an
12 amendment has caused it to be printed in the portion of
13 the Congressional Record designated for that purpose in
14 clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments so printed shall be
15 considered as read. At the conclusion of consideration of
16 the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and re-
17 port the bill to the House with such amendments as may
18 have been adopted. The previous question shall be consid-
19 ered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to
20 final passage without intervening motion except one mo-
21 tion to recommit with or without instructions.
