A BILL

To revise the boundary of the Kaloko-Honokōhau National
Historical Park in the State of Hawaii, and for other
purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Kaloko-Honokōhau
5 National Historical Park Addition Act of 2003”.

1 **SEC. 2. ADDITIONS TO KALOKO-HONOKŌHAU NATIONAL**
2 **HISTORICAL PARK.**

3 Section 505(a) of Public Law 95–625 (16 U.S.C.
4 396d(a)) is amended—

5 (1) by striking “(a) In order” and inserting
6 “(a)(1) In order”;

7 (2) by striking “1978,” and all that follows and
8 inserting “1978.”; and

9 (3) by adding at the end the following new
10 paragraphs:

11 “(2) The boundaries of the park are modified
12 to include lands and interests therein comprised of
13 Parcels 1 and 2 totaling 2.14 acres, identified as
14 ‘Tract A’ on the map entitled ‘Kaloko-Honokōhau
15 National Historical Park Proposed Boundary Ad-
16 justment’, numbered PWR (PISO) 466/82,043 and
17 dated April 2002.

18 “(3) The maps referred to in this subsection
19 shall be on file and available for public inspection in
20 the appropriate offices of the National Park Serv-
21 ice.”.

22 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATIONS OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

23 There are authorized to be appropriated such sums
24 as may be necessary to carry out this Act.
