Mr. GRAHAM of South Carolina introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

## A BILL

For the relief of Griselda Lopez Negrete.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4       Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-  
5       poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
6       1101 et seq.), Griselda Lopez Negrete shall be held and  
7       considered to have been lawfully admitted to the United  
8       States for permanent residence as of the date of enact-  
9       ment of this Act upon payment of the required visa fees.

10       **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

11       Upon the granting of permanent residence to Gri-  
12       selda Lopez Negrete, as provided in section 1, the Sec-

1   retary of State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce  
2   by the appropriate number during the current fiscal year  
3   the total number of immigrant visas available to natives  
4   of the country of the alien's birth under section 203(a)  
5   of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
6   1153(a)).
