**A BILL**

To extend the authority for the construction of a memorial to Martin Luther King, Jr.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MEMORIAL TO MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.**

4 Section 508(b) of the Omnibus Parks and Public  
 5 Lands Management Act of 1996 (110 Stat. 4157) is  
 6 amended—

7 (1) by striking “The establishment” and all  
 8 that follows through the period at the end and in-  
 9 serting the following:

10 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in para-  
 11 graph (2), the establishment of the memorial shall  
 12 be in accordance with chapter 89 of title 40, United  
 13 States Code.”; and

14 (2) by inserting after paragraph (1) (as des-  
 15 ignated by paragraph (1)) the following:

16 “(2) EXCEPTION.—Notwithstanding section  
 17 8903(e) of title 40, United States Code, the author-  
 18 ity provided by this section terminates on November  
 19 12, 2006.”.

20 **SECTION. 1. MEMORIAL TO MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.**

21 *Section 508(b) of the Omnibus Parks and Public*  
 22 *Lands Management Act of 1996 (Public Law 104–333, as*  
 23 *amended is amended to read as follows:*

24 “(b) COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS FOR COMMEMO-  
 25 RATIVE WORKS.—

1           “(1) *Except as provided in paragraph (2), the*  
2           *establishment of the memorial shall be in accordance*  
3           *with chapter 89 of title 40, United States Code.*

4           “(2) *Notwithstanding section 8903(e) of title 40,*  
5           *United States Code, the authority provided by this*  
6           *section terminates on November 12, 2006.”.*
