## **JOINT RESOLUTION**

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States with respect to the right to life.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives

- 6 when ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the

2	"Section 1. With respect to the right to life, the
3	word 'person' as used in this article and in the fifth and
4	fourteenth articles of amendment applies to all human
5	beings irrespective of age, health, function, or condition
6	of dependency, including their unborn offspring at every
7	state of their biological development.
8	"Section 2. No unborn person shall be deprived of
9	life by any person: Provided, however, That nothing in this
10	article shall prohibit a law permitting only those medical
11	procedures required to prevent the death of the mother
12	of an unborn person: Provided further, That nothing in
