A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. VINCENT PALLADINO POST OFFICE.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 567 Tompkins Avenue in Staten

1 Island, New York, shall be known and designated as the
2 “Vincent Palladino Post Office”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Vincent Palladino
7 Post Office”.
