2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CLAYTON J. SMITH MEMORIAL POST OFFICE**
4 **BUILDING.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 770 Trumbull Drive in Pitts-
7 burgh, Pennsylvania, shall be known and designated as the
8 “Clayton J. Smith Memorial Post Office Building”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
4 be deemed to be a reference to the “Clayton J. Smith Me-
5 morial Post Office Building”.
