## A BILL

To amend the Lacey Act Amendments of 1981 to add non-human primates to the definition of prohibited wildlife species.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Captive Primate Safety  
5 Act of 2005”.

1 **SEC. 2. ADDITION OF NON-HUMAN PRIMATES TO THE DEFINITION OF PROHIBITED WILDLIFE SPECIES.**

3 Section 2(g) of the Lacey Act Amendments of 1981  
4 (16 U.S.C. 3371(g)) is amended by inserting “or any non-  
5 human primate” before the period at the end.
