AN ACT

To restore the prohibition on the commercial sale and
slaughter of wild free-roaming horses and burros.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SALE OF WILD FREE-ROAMING HORSES AND**
2 **BURROS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 3(d)(5) of Public Law
4 92–195 (16 U.S.C. 1333(d)(5)) is amended—

5 (1) by striking the period and inserting the fol-
6 lowing: “*Provided*, That no wild free-roaming horse
7 or burro or its remains may be sold or transferred
8 for consideration for processing into commercial
9 products.”; and

10 (2) by striking subsection (e).

11 (b) CRIMINAL PROVISIONS.—Section (8)(a)(4) of
12 Public Law 92–195 (16 U.S.C. 1338(a)(4)) is amended
13 by striking “except as provided in section 3(e),”.
