A BILL

To amend section 5112(p)(1)(A) of title 31, United States Code, to allow an exception from the \$1 coin dispensing capability requirement for certain vending machines.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That section 5112(p)(1)(A) of title 31, United States
4 Code, is amended to read as follows:

5 “(A) any business operations conducted by
6 any such agency, instrumentality, system, or
7 entity that involve coins or currency will be
8 fully capable of—

1 “(i) accepting \$1 coins in connection
2 with such operations; and

3 “(ii) other than vending machines
4 that do not receive currency denominations
5 higher than \$1, dispensing \$1 coins in con-
6 nection with such operations; and”.
