To designate the Port Angeles Federal Building in Port
Angeles, Washington, as the “Richard B. Anderson Fed-
eral Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RICHARD B. ANDERSON FEDERAL BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The Federal building located at
5 138 West First Street, Port Angeles, Washington, shall

1 be known and designated as the “Richard B. Anderson
2 Federal Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the Federal building referred to in subsection
6 (a) shall be deemed to be a reference to the “Richard B.
7 Anderson Federal Building”.

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
