Mr. WALSH of New York introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

## A BILL

For the relief of William Becker.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PAYMENT TO WILLIAM BECKER.**

4 Not later than 90 days after the date of the enact-  
5 ment of this Act, the Secretary of the Treasury shall pay,  
6 out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appro-  
7 priated, to William Becker of Baldwinsville, New York,  
8 \$5,462, which is the overpayment of Federal income tax  
9 that would result if Revenue Ruling 80-173 (1980-2 C.B.  
10 60) (relating to veteran flight training) did not apply to  
11 William Becker.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON ATTORNEY AND AGENT FEES.**

2       It shall be unlawful for an amount exceeding 10 per-  
3 cent of the amount paid pursuant to section 1 to be paid  
4 to, or received by, any agent or attorney for any service  
5 rendered in connection with the payment under section 1.  
6 Any person who violates this section shall be guilty of an  
7 infraction and shall be subject to a fine in the amount  
8 provided in title 18, United States Code.
