A BILL

To prohibit a Federal agency from accepting a form of individual identification issued by a foreign government, except a passport that is accepted on the date of enactment.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Identification Integrity
5 Act of 2007”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON ACCEPTANCE OF IDENTIFICATION**
2 **ISSUED BY FOREIGN GOVERNMENTS.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—A Federal agency may not accept,
4 for any official purpose, an identification document for an
5 individual if the identification document is issued by a for-
6 eign government.

7 (b) **EXCEPTION.**—If a passport issued by a foreign
8 government is authorized by Federal law to be accepted
9 for a specific official purpose on the date of the enactment
10 of this Act, subsection (a) shall not be construed to affect
11 such authorization.

12 (c) **DEFINITION.**—For purposes of this section, the
13 term “Federal agency” means—

14 (1) an Executive agency (as defined in section
15 105 of title 5, United States Code);

16 (2) a military department (as defined in section
17 102 of title 5, United States Code);

18 (3) an office, agency, or other establishment in
19 the legislative branch of the Government of the
20 United States;

21 (4) an office, agency, or other establishment in
22 the judicial branch of the Government of the United
23 States; and

24 (5) the government of the District of Columbia.
